

THE HUMANITIES & WESTERN CIVILIZATION WRITING CONTEST

The Humanities & Western Civilization Program will award a cash prize of \$200.00 for the best essay on a topic emerging out of issues raised in a Humanities or Western Civilization course. Any student enrolled in a Humanities or Western Civilization class during the past academic year is eligible to enter.

Essays must be typed, double-spaced, and written in grammatically correct English. Proper citation must be used for quotations and a complete bibliography of sources—following the MLA Handbook—must be appended to the essay. Length should not exceed 2500 words. Applicants should consult with their instructor about their interest in applying and submit a copy of the original assignment with the paper. Winning essays will be judged on originality, content, correct form, and style.

Three copies of each essay must be submitted for blind reviews. Authors should include their name, address, email address, course and instructor's name on a *removable* cover sheet. Entries must be received at the Humanities & Western Civilization Program office, 308 Bailey Hall, by 5 p.m., Friday, April 16, 2010.

The recipient will be notified by letter.
