

**The Ted Johnson  
Interrelations of the Humanities & the Arts Award  
2010**

**Amount:** up to \$500

**Eligibility:** undergraduate and graduate students and instructors

**Project:** The award will be made for an interdisciplinary project in the Humanities or Fine Arts. Preference will be given to applicants whose project includes the French language, literature, or culture as an integral part of the plan.

Funds may be used to defray travel expenses to a library, museum, or exhibition; to attend a concert or theatrical performance in this country or abroad; to acquire materials or books to complete a project or teach a course.

**Application:** Applicants should provide the following:

1. A one-page description of the project, including anticipated expenses;
2. A one-page narrative describing the applicant's qualifications and the expected results of the project as well as its benefits;
3. One letter of support from a professor or advisor in the case of all students, or from a colleague or departmental chair in the case of faculty. Recipient will be asked to write a brief report on completion of the project and attach all relevant materials. These will be kept on file for future reference;
4. All materials should be submitted to the HWC office, 308 Bailey Hall.

**DEADLINE: April 16, 2010**

**Review:** Applications will be reviewed by a committee chaired by the director of HWC and including the director of the KU Honors Program, a representative of the Department of French & Italian, and a representative of the School of Fine Arts.
